Sales Agreement

This contract is made by and between Steadfast Standard Schnauzers, hereinafter referred to as seller(s) and _____ hereinafter referred to as buyer(s), to provide for the subsequent care, treatment, and nurturing of the puppy/dog herein described above. It is agreed to by both the buyer(s) and seller(s) that the term “puppy” shall be defined as: “being any dog under 18 months of age”.

In exchange for the above described puppy/dog, a monetary consideration of (state sales tax included) will be given the seller(s). The terms of the payment are:

There is a required, **NON-REFUNDABLE**, deposit equal to half the total price which is to be paid immediately in the form of cash, money order, or cashier’s check (made payable to **Steadfast Standard Schnauzers**) The remaining balance will be paid at the time of the puppy pick-up.

The seller(s) attest to the puppy/dog as having no known illnesses or deficiencies of health. The buyer(s) understands that within the first week after purchasing the puppy/dog, said buyer has the option to have the puppy/dog examined by a veterinarian of the buyer(s) choice, and this examination of the puppy/dog is at the buyer(s) expense. Should any illnesses or deficiency of health be found, the puppy/dog may be returned to the seller at the buyer(s) expense for a full monetary refund of the purchase price. The return of said puppy/dog must happen within two weeks of sales agreement signing date.

The seller(s) guarantees the puppy/dog to be free of genetic defect(s) within the first two years of life. Examples of these defects include; hip dysplasia, blindness, and DCM. Ear infections, dry skin, parvo, over/under shot bite, and any other illness or diseases that can be induced by environment will not be the responsibility of the seller(s). Any and all expenses incurred due to disease, whether genetic or environmental, is the sole responsibility of the buyer(s). If, within two years the puppy/dog is determined to have a genetic defect as determined by both buyer(s) and seller(s) designated veterinarian, a puppy from the next available litter will be provided free of charge by seller(s).

The buyer(s), at their option, may return the puppy/dog within the first two weeks after receiving the puppy. A refund, not to exceed 50% of the sale price, will be refunded to the buyer(s) within two weeks of the puppy/dog return to seller(s). Transportation of puppy/dog back to seller(s) is the responsibility of the buyer(s).

Within three weeks after delivery of puppy/dog, all documents required to register your puppy/dog with the AKC will be supplied by seller(s). All fees required to finish registration of puppy/dog are the responsibility of the buyer(s). The puppy/dog will have a "limited registration" with the AKC. The buyer(s) agree to never use any puppy/dog that is included in this contract in any breeding program.

Spay/Neuter Agreement: Breeders hand select which offspring will be used to breed based on the breed standards and temperaments. Breeding stock must be of appropriate age/weight, health, temperament and promote the same in their future offspring. To guarantee the success of the breed, it is crucial that only the best adult dogs be bred, resulting in exceptional puppies that will carry on the breed standards. Buyer agrees that this dog is being purchased as a pet only, and that the guarantee of show or breeding quality is neither made nor implied. Permanent ownership of this companion pet is contingent upon your compliance that there is a breeding restriction placed on this dog. This means that you will not be able to register any offspring from this dog unless seller gives written permission to AKC to lift the restriction.

When to spay/neuter: Like vaccines and many routine veterinary procedures, vets spend a lot of time discussing why you should spay or neuter your dog but spend very little time talking about why you shouldn't. Generally, this should not be done before the dog has reached 24 months of age. For this reason, if the buyer decides to spay or neuter the puppy before 24 months of age, the seller's guarantee that puppy/dog is free of defects is null and void.

It is agreed to by both the buyer(s) and seller(s) that this dog is not be resold. If at any time in the future the buyer(s) either cannot or chooses not to keep or properly care for the puppy/dog, said puppy/dog will be returned to seller(s). The return of puppy/dog to seller(s) will not result in any refund. Transportation of the puppy/dog back to the seller(s) is the responsibility of the buyer(s).
